To Whom it May Concern -

This letter constitutes a request under the Connecticut Freedom on Information law, specifically Section 1-210 of the Freedom of Information Act, as well as other relevant portions of the law.

I write to request access to a copy of the University of Connecticut Athletic Department comprehensive budget for the 2007-2008 year, and the 2008-2009 year. I would also like copies of statements and receipts of travel expenditures for all members of Connecticut's football coaching staff during the period between Nov. 1, 2008 and Mar. 31, 2009. This includes every member of the football staff of coach Randy Edsall that were cleared by the NCAA to work as recruiters.

Additionally, please provide copies of statements and receipts of travel expenditures for all members of Connecticut's basketball coaching staff during the period between Jan. 1, 2008 and Dec. 31, 2008. This includes every member of the basketball staff of coach Jim Calhoun that were cleared by the NCAA to work as recruiters.

I am requesting only documents that pertain to university business and conform to Connecticut state statute. I would prefer this document in electronic form as a PDF but will accept a paper copy. If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address.

I agree to pay any reasonable copying and postage fees of not more than \$50.00. If the cost would be greater than this amount, please notify me. Please provide a receipt indicating the charges for each document. As provided by the Connecticut Freedom of Information Act, I would request your response within four (4) business days. If the task would take longer than the four business days, additional time can be added, though we request to be told a reasonable date that the task would be completed.

If you choose to deny this request, please provide a written explanation for the denial, including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. Also, please provide all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material.
